

ZIFA to Establish Ad Hoc Committee to Investigate Sheasham FC Withdrawal

The Zimbabwe Football Association (ZIFA) Executive Committee, at its meeting held on 9 October 2025, has resolved to establish an Ad Hoc Committee of Inquiry to investigate the withdrawal of Sheasham Football Club from the Zimbabwe Central Region Soccer League (ZCRSL). The decision follows recommendations from the ZIFA Legal and Player Status Committee meeting convened on 8 October 2025.

In accordance with Article 55 of the ZIFA Statutes, the Ad Hoc Committee shall be constituted as follows:

- 1. A Chairperson, who shall be a qualified legal practitioner
- 2. A Deputy Chairperson, who shall be a sports administrator
- 3. One member, who shall be a former referee

The Committee's Terms of Reference are to:

- a) Investigate the circumstances surrounding Sheasham FC's withdrawal from the ZCRSL, including any related complaints;
- b) Determine whether Sheasham FC exhausted all internal remedies available under the ZIFA Statutes and ZCRSL regulations prior to withdrawal;
- c) Assess the response of the ZCRSL to any complaints lodged by Sheasham FC; and
- d) Submit a written report of findings and recommendations to the ZIFA Executive Committee within seven (7) working days from the date of appointment.

The ZIFA Secretariat has been tasked, under the guidance of the Executive Committee, to facilitate the appointment of committee members and provide the necessary administrative support to ensure the effective functioning of the Committee.
