

For the first time in our history, we are deploying a fully governed, national youth league system that places schools, communities, provinces and national teams inside one coherent development pipeline.

For too long, youth football has been fragmented, informal and unequal. Talent has been lost simply because young players were invisible to the system. With Roots Impact, that era ends. This programme integrates football directly into the education ecosystem, ensures every child is registered, safeguarded and monitored, and creates a merit-based national pathway that reaches every province and every community.

Our partnership with BancABC is fundamental. They are not merely sponsoring a competition — they are financing the future of Zimbabwean football by providing the financial, governance and ESG infrastructure that allows this system to operate with transparency, credibility and national reach.

Zimbabwe's youth football has historically been characterised by:



Fragmented competitions



Unequal access between urban and rural areas



Weak safeguarding and child protection



No structured pathway to elite football



Social risks including school drop-out, drugs and teenage pregnancy

The BancABC Roots Impact Programme was created to replace this with a single, nationally governed system.

They are designed as a year-round development platform, not a once-off tournament. The goal is simple: manufacture football talent in a safe, governed and merit-based environment.



The Four National Leagues

Zimbabwe now operates four fully national junior leagues for the season of **March to August**:

This is a year league system, so with 18 matches per team per season, there are 40 provincial teams, and 10 girls and 10 boys teams per province, there are 720+ official youth matches per year.


All BancABC Roots Impact Programme matches are played through five national competition hubs:

How Children Enter

Players enter the system through:

- 01** Schools (via the ZIFA-MoPSE MOU) - NAPH and NASH
- 02** Community junior leagues
- 03** Open provincial trials
- 04** Existing academies
- 05** ZIFA-affiliated clubs

Every player is:

- Registered on FIFA Connect
- Covered by child-protection frameworks
- Tracked for long-term development

No child is invisible.
No province is excluded.
